- Rates:\$140.00/month to be paid at the beginning of the month for half hour weekly lessons. Some months may have 5 of the same weekday or may contain a holiday. The amount to be paid per month will be the same regardless and will balance out over the course of a year. Hourly rates are 180/month. Single hourly lessons are 60/hour.
- No lessons on the following Holidays:
Christmas, Thanksgiving, Memorial Day, Labor Day, July 4th.
- Make-Ups will only be considered with at least a 24 hour notice and must be made up that week if the schedule allows, LOG will always try to accommodate but if there is no opening for the make up you simply will not receive one nor credit towards another lesson. **If the teacher is unable to attend a lesson** the student can choose to reschedule, receive credit, or be refunded.
- Credit for Cancellations: There will be no monetary credit for cancellations or absences of any kind (*unless teacher is unable to make the lesson, see Make-Ups above*). The billing cycle is monthly and once the month has started you are locked into that time slot for the month. However, notifying LOG of a schedule change before the next billing a lesson may be deducted for that month. **Example:** You will miss a lesson in December and notify LOG in November about the schedule change. Your bill for December will now have one lesson (\$35.00) deducted from the total for that month.
- Recitals: There will be 2 **Until further notice all recitals** recitals per year (TBA) one in the winter and one in the **Cancelled due to Covid** summer. There is a 40.00 fee for all who perform to cover the costs of the rental space, equipment, and other musicians, photographers, professionals involved.
- Students are responsible for their own materials, instruments, and need to follow their instructors recommended practice schedule. There will be graded course work and a quarterly progress report. Students must meet instructors set level of musicality and performance goals or the student will not be allowed to continue.
